NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 1st July 2020 Steamship Mutual Underwriting Association Limited (“**SMUAL**”) and Steamship Mutual Underwriting Association (Europe) Limited (“**SMUAE**”) applied to the High Court of Justice of England and Wales pursuant to section 107(1) of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 (“**FSMA**”) for:

1. an Order sanctioning an insurance business transfer scheme providing for the transfer to SMUAE of certain insurance and reinsurance business of SMUAL (the “**Scheme**”); and
2. an Order making ancillary provisions in connection with the Scheme pursuant to Section 112 of FSMA.

The application is directed to be heard before a Judge of the Business and Property Courts of the High Court at **The Rolls Building, 7 Rolls Buildings, Fetter Lane, London, EC4A 1NL** on 2 December 2020. If approved by the Court, it is proposed that the Scheme will take effect on 20 December 2020. Any person who alleges that he or she would be adversely affected by the carrying out of the Scheme is entitled to appear at the hearing and/or to make representations in person and/or to instruct a barrister or solicitor advocate to appear at the hearing and make representations on his or her behalf and/or to make written representations without appearing at the hearing.

If anyone intends to appear at the hearing in person or to instruct someone to appear on their behalf, we would request that he or she give notice of their intention to do so setting out the reasons why he or she would be adversely affected.
