Article 74

- 1- The ship Master must declare to the Customs within 24 hours of the vessel's arrival at Dakar port:
- a) As summary declaration:
 - The cargo manifest with, if required, its authentic translation in Senegal's official language
 - The special manifests of the ship's stores and crew personal effects
- b) The charter parties or bills of lading, acts of nationality and any other document which may be requested by the Customs for the enforcement of the Customs rules
 - The foreign vessels are exempted from the submission of the act of nationality. They are only obliged to show it to the Customs office.
- 2- The summary declaration must be made even if the vessel is on ballast
